The City of Lake Charles' minimum foundation elevation requirement shall not relieve any property owner of his/her obligations under Louisiana Civil Code Articles 655 and 656 to not adversely impact or unreasonably burden adjacent properties due to the alteration of the natural drainage of the area; furthermore, the City of Lake Charles does not warrant to any property owner that their compliance with the City's minimum foundation elevation requirement can guarantee that in no event or every possible situation the property owner's property will never experience an incident of flooding.

## Special Notes:

- 1. Install permit placard in a readily accessible location free of mud, debris, or other hazards.
- 2. Storm-water controls must be maintained until a Certificate of Occupancy is issued.
- 3. Property lines must be clearly marked prior to the foundation inspection. When property stakes are over 80' apart provide rope or other suitable material between stakes.
- 4. Work shall not proceed until each division has approved the various stages of construction.
- 5. Issuance of this permit does not release the permittee from fully complying with all federal, state, and local laws. It is the responsibility of the permittee to identify all federal, state, and local laws relative to the permitted activity and ensure full compliance prior to commencement of work.
- 6. Where applicable port-o-lets and site dumpsters are required before inspections are made.

Construction debris is **not** eligible for pick up by the City of Lake Charles and is the responsibility of the owner/contractor.

Separate permits are required for electrical, mechanical, & plumbing.
